HOLLAND, INDONESIA SIGN 13-YEAR DISPUTE ENDS AT U.N.

AGREEMENT * ON WEST **NEW GUINEA**

NEW YORK, August 16 (A.A.P.).—Holland and Indonesia last night signed the formal agree-ment to transfer West New Guinea to Indonesia after May 1 next year. after May 1 next year.

The agreement provides for a cease-fire at 10.1 a.m. on Saturday (Sydney time) and for an immediate resumption of diplomatic relations between the two countries involved in the 13-year-old dispute.
